

# NEW SHOES, NEW MOTIVATION



We spent quality time with our youth and community members, distributing 100 pairs of shoes and socks to the youth. Of the greatest needs asked of youth experiencing homelessness, 72% share that shoes are essential. As a result, 79% report increased physical activity, and having new shoes gives 95% of youth more confidence, making them excited to attend and participate in new opportunities, join extracurricular activities, and more. By increasing general equity, we acknowledge a positive correlation between new shoes and overall performance from youth, academically and socially. We are grateful to everyone who participated and to the youth for attending this event.

#### 100 Shoes to 100 Youth

This past month, we had the privilege of partnering with UnitedHealthcare to host a shoe donation event. We organized a bright and cheerful morning in the park for our youth. The event featured motivational speeches by prominent personalities, including the city of Costa Mesa officials and LA Charger Linebacker, Kenneth Murray Jr. Our aim was to inspire the youth to overcome obstacles and pursue their aspirations.
