OUR IMPACT

In 2024, we provided:

31,471 VOLUNTEER HOURS

This incredible contribution of time and dedication from our volunteers allowed us to extend our reach and make a lasting impact on the lives of youth experiencing homelessness.

69,464 NUTRITIOUS MEALS

We served thousands of meals, ensuring that no youth in our programs went hungry and had the energy needed to pursue their goals.

7,966 NIGHTS OF EMERGENCY SHELTER

Each night provided a safe space and peace of mind for youth in crisis, giving them the stability to begin rebuilding their lives.

2,855 YOUTH NEW TO OUR PROGRAMS

We welcomed nearly 3,000 youth into our community, offering them hope, resources, and support for a brighter future.

1,639 YOUTH MENTORED

Our dedicated mentors guided and inspired these young people, helping them navigate challenges and realize their potential.

952 YOUTH IN MAINTAINED HOUSING

Thanks to our housing programs and ongoing support, hundreds of young adults have found and sustained stable housing, breaking the cycle of homelessness.

100% HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATE
